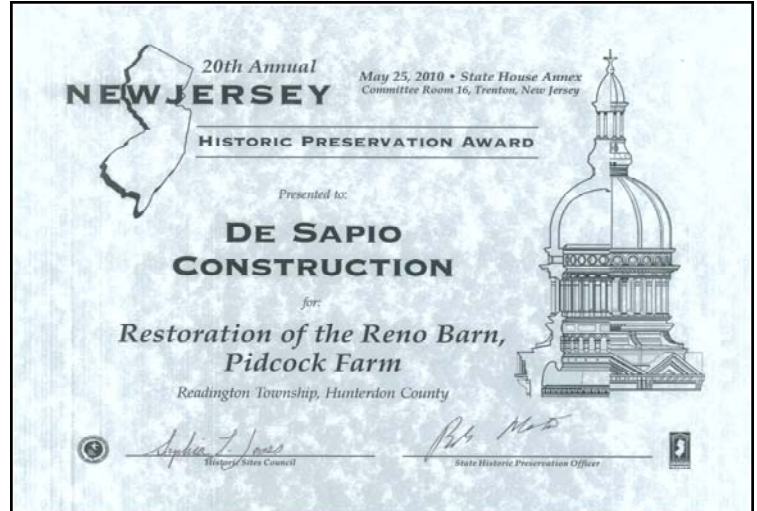


Ann Reno Barn / Pidcock Farm



The Ann Reno Barn is an English style barn that dates back to the 19th century. The Barn was disassembled in 2005 from the Reno farm and stored. In 2009 De Sapiro Construction was contracted to begin the reconstruction on the Pidcock Farm Nature Preserve. A new stone foundation was constructed and the barn structure was re-assembled utilizing a majority of the existing beams. New roof rafters were reproduced to match the existing. New barn doors were fabricated utilizing clinch nails and period hardware. At its new home near Route 22 on the 100 acre Cushetunk Nature Preserve - the Ann Reno Barn will be available for class field trips and other gatherings.
