De Sapio Construction Inc. was contracted to construct a snack stand and plaza which was to compliment the historical design of the adjacent bath houses. These bath houses were designed by the famous 20th century architect Louis Kahn. Kahn's work can be found in the U.S, India and Bangladesh and is said to reveal an integration of structure, a reverence for materials and light, a devotion to architectural geometry, and a profound concern for humanistic values. Construction of the snack bar followed a design similar to that of Kahn's work but was slightly different to complement Kahn's design. The doors and serving windows found in the stand were all milled and constructed in our shop of sinker cypress to match the existing while incorporating modern hardware for security.
