The project consisted of an addition and renovation of the existing emergency services building. The 6,000 sf addition housed a new dispatch room with the latest technology including the installation of a new emergency generator and uninterrupted power supply. Site work consisted of a new sewage disposal system and storm water management system. The existing building was renovated into administration offices after the new dispatch center was operational. The construction mandated that our Firm complete the project while maintaining this critical building service to Hunterdon's 128,000 citizens fully functional as the county's emergency management and 911 dispatching call center.
